

Canoe inventory with photos

The following is a list of canoes as part of the Miller Canoe estate. This is a collection of canoes that range in date from the early 1900's on to the current time frame and were collected by Bill Miller as part of a mini museum. Listed are what we know of the size and build from a list Bill had put together in 2018. The 19' canoes listed are from the original Vic Miller 1925. The 20' Moore canoes were from the Bert Moore model purchased by Vic Miller in 1956. Moore canoes built before this date would have been built by Mr. Moore. Most of the 20-26 foot V stern canoes were built from this mold. Although I have noted that these canoes were Miller or Moore vessels, some of these canoes listed may have been Chesnutt, Barker, BN Morris and other builders over this time period.

The following ratings have been given:

Excellent: As new condition

Good: Serviceable with no structural damage and wear consistent with age.

Fair: Serviceable, with some minor damage and significant wear

Poor: Suitable to build furniture with.

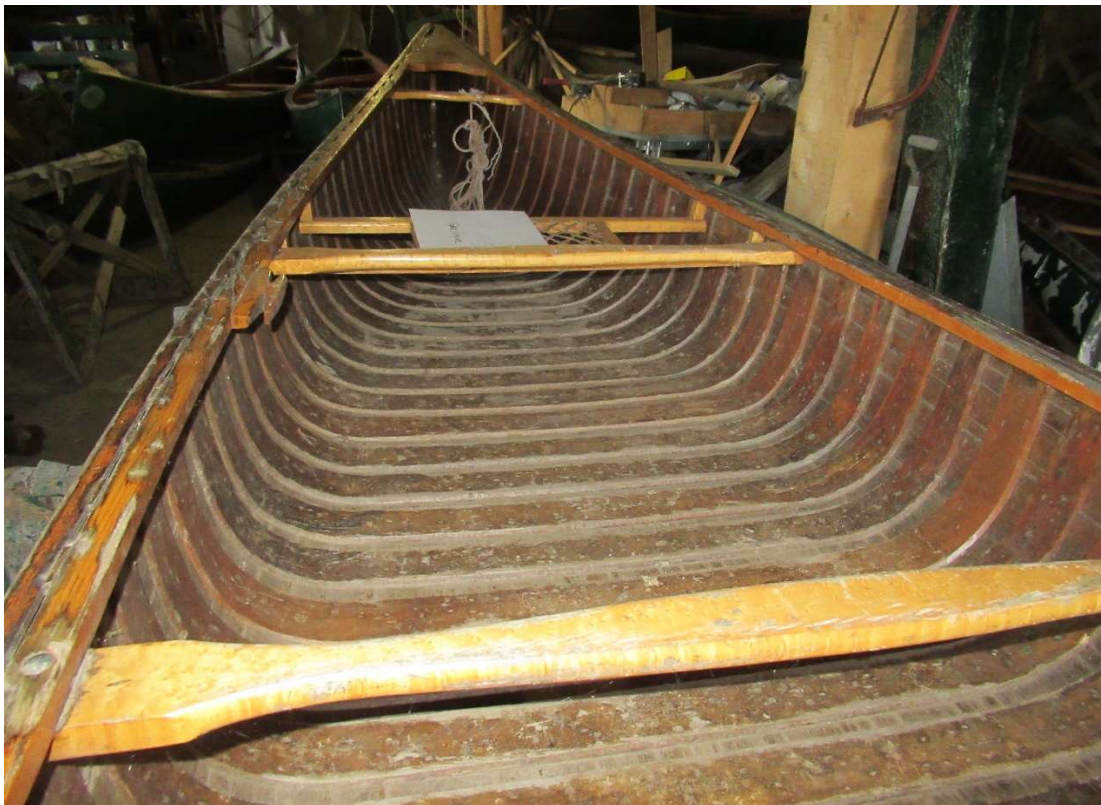
1. 19' Miller SN 088 Good condition, wood/fiberglass

4. 19' Miller in Fair/good condition with hole in bow, wood/fiberglass



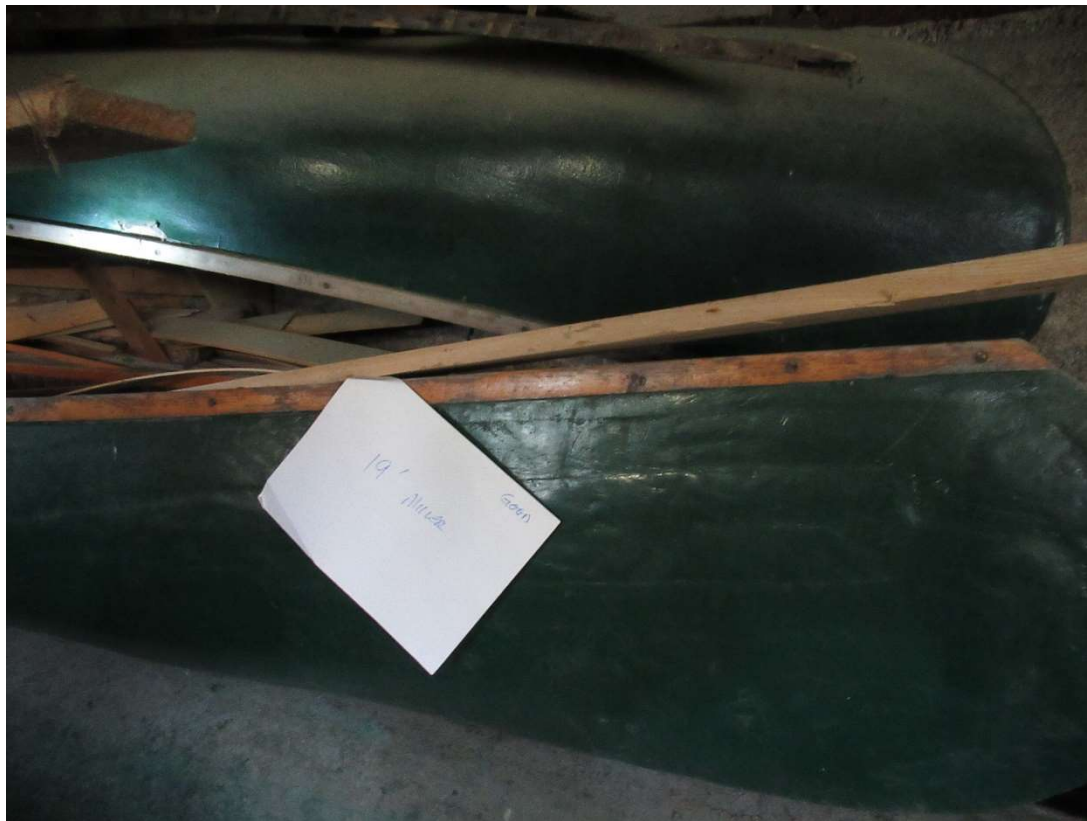
5. 19' Miller in Fair condition

8. 20' Moore in good condition, wood/canvas and is above the canoe in 7

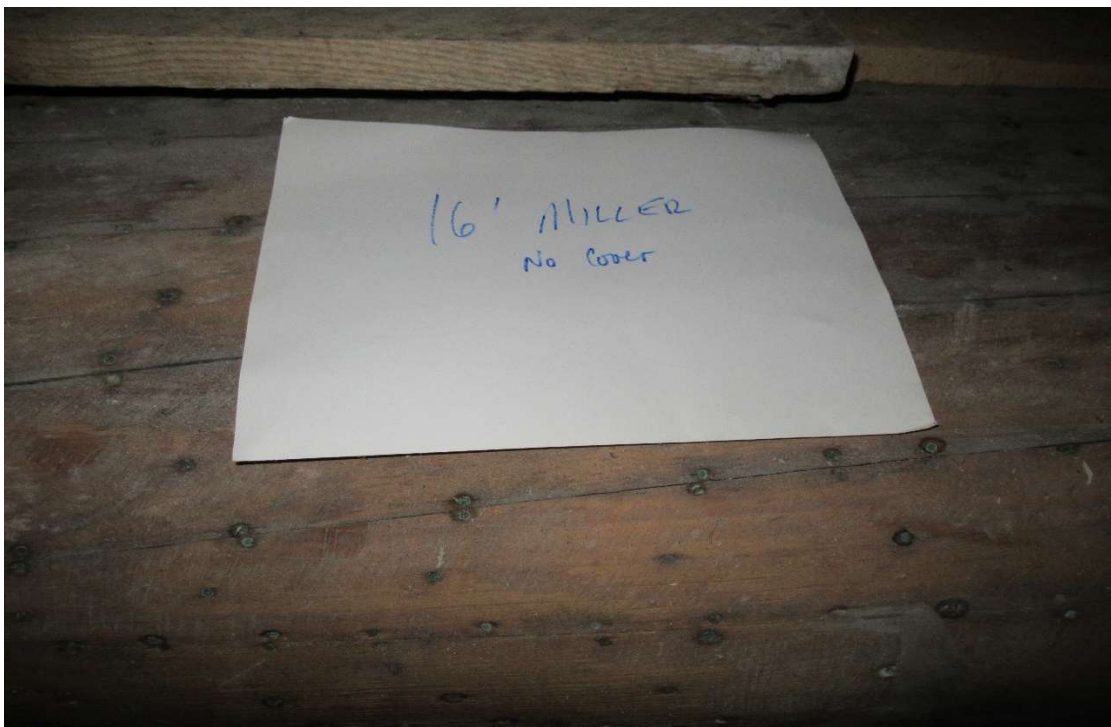


9. 22' Moore, Good condition wood/fiberglass, the bottom canoe

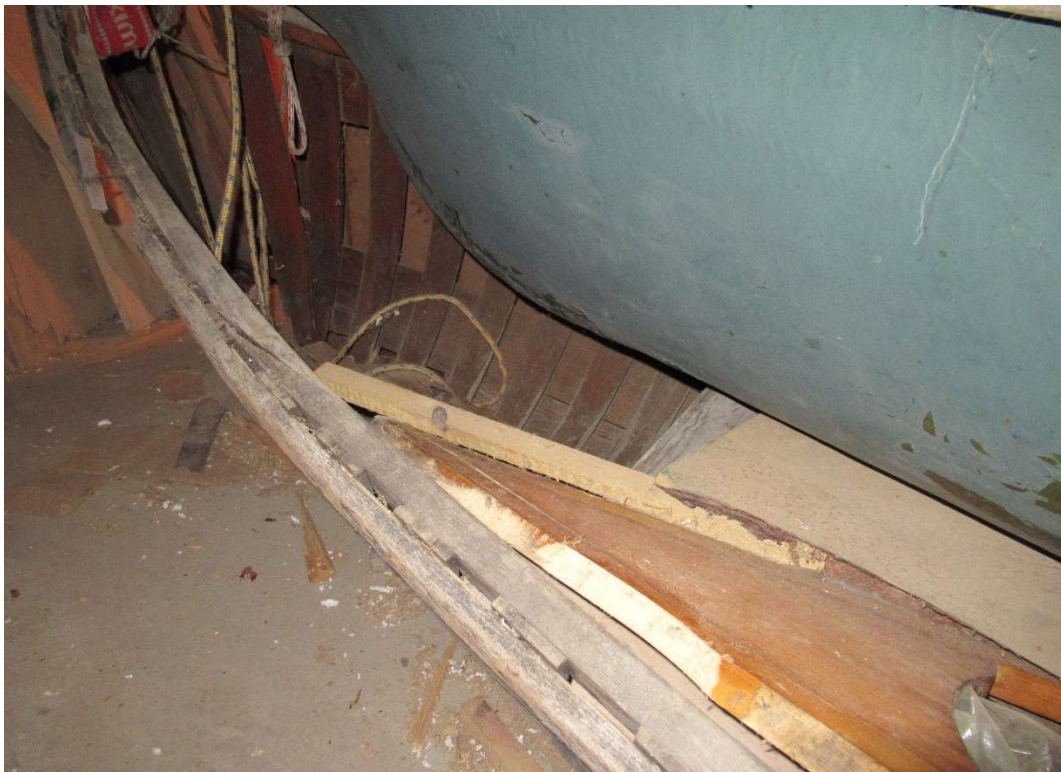
