


## Select 'Upload a File'



Because I also wondered about this when I first became a member, and find it easier to see how to do something then read about it - here is a document that contains a series of screen shots that show exactly how to upload photos. I collected these screen shots as I replied to your message.

Photos can be uploaded in full size, or as thumbnails. **Full-size** images make it more work to scroll through a thread (I learned the hard way!). **Thumbnail** images will expand in a separate window when people click on them so that seems to be the way to go.

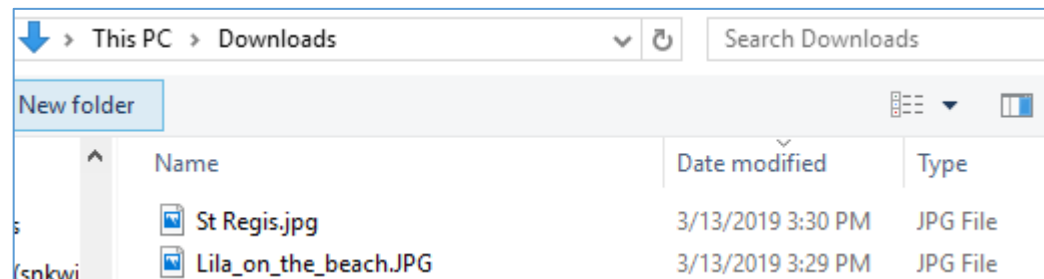
As an example, I'm attaching **full-size** image of my wonderful dog, and a thumbnail image of me standing on top of St. Regis mountain in winter.


Post Reply Upload a File More Options...

Navigate to the folder than contains the images and select them.



Once the images appear at the bottom of the message select how you would like them loaded, either as **thumbnails** or **full-size** images (they should appear in your message in the order that you select them).

If you are loading a number of images, and you want all of them loaded the same way just select which size you want using the **"Insert every images as a ..."** option at the top.
