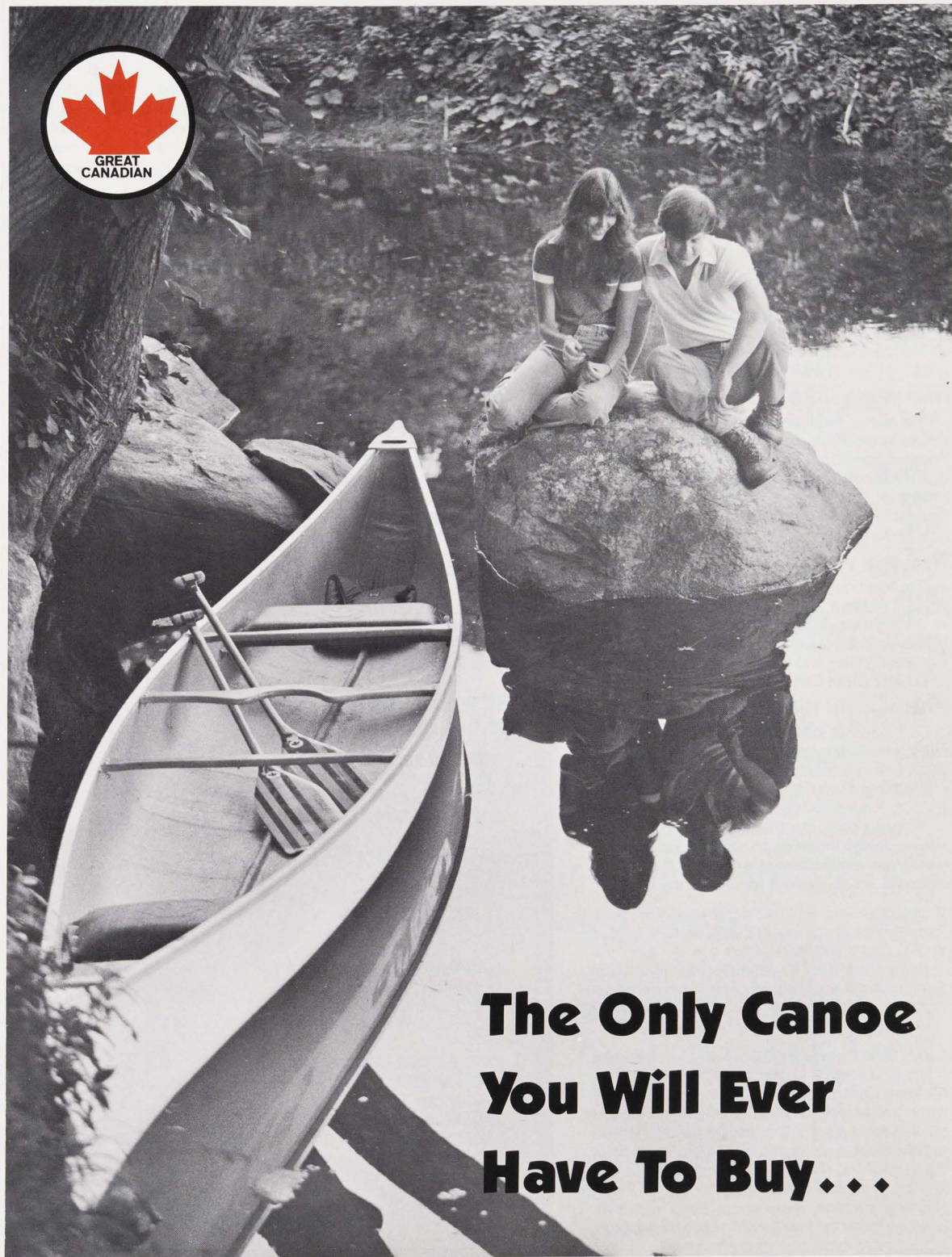

What Canoe For You?

Study your needs first. For what purpose are you going to use it? For how many people? Where and how often will you use it? Great Canadian Canoes are designed and built safe and stable for various uses. Let Great Canadian and their pros be your guide.

What Length Canoe For You?

Generally, a longer canoe is more stable and easier to paddle. It is wise to buy a canoe a little longer than you think you need. You grow into it. But, as the length increases so does the price. We try to give you those extra 2" or 3" in length for added performance and stability at the lower price. Ask your Great Canadian pro!

What Width and Depth For You?

The wider the canoe the more stable. We refuse to make too narrow or shallow a canoe! These dimensions increase the price but safety is number one with us. Our widths of 37¼" and depths of 13½" are engineered in *balance* for performance and stability. If it is 37¼" wide then it should be that wide!

What Hull Shape For You?

Canadian canoes have developed over 400+ years. We have a time proven shallow "V" hull with a slight rocker, a good flair (tumble home) that gives you stability with speed. Each canoe has its own personality and feel. You are going to have fun in any Great Canadian canoe...

What Material For You?

Go to a boat show! 98% of all the boats are fiberglass. **Fiberglass**—In canoes hand laid up glass is *very important*. The canoe must be light and strong. Great Canadian canoes are *Hand Laid Up*. Fiberglass is flexible and feels the waves. It has good color, durable, is easily repaired and has no design limitations. The Glass content and the belted reinforcement we put in at strategic places is very important, (priced for the family).

Aluminum—The light traditional strong material. Excellent for rental use but must be heat treated to T-6 and .050" thick. Ours are the best the industry has to offer. Excellent for hard tough use. Some find the boats slightly noisy with denting a problem and a tendency to hang up on river rocks. (Priced 29-35% more than fiberglass).

Cedar Strip Canvas PVC Coated—Just beautiful...this is elegance and grace where the canoe Heritage began. You feel the water, you love the wood. You know that Indians make them for you on the reservation. The design is stable with excellent dimensions and close ribs. Never paint the tough P.V.C. (Poly Vinyl Chloride) exterior. The interior is finished with three coats of tough acrylic eurathane. Store under cover in winter. Buy one today, for the discriminating owner. (only 7-11% more expensive than aluminum).

Royalex A.B.S.—A tough modern material molded into shape. Excellent for hard repeated river work. (On some beware of ultra violet light and cold fatigue.) They can and do break (I've seen them) and repairs are difficult. An expensive canoe with over emphasis on strength for the average canoeist. If you do white water once a year let a rental canoe go from rock to rock. (Priced 89% more than fiberglass).

Kevlar—A new material very light and strong.

Good for racing over long distances. V material for reinforcement more than fiberglass.

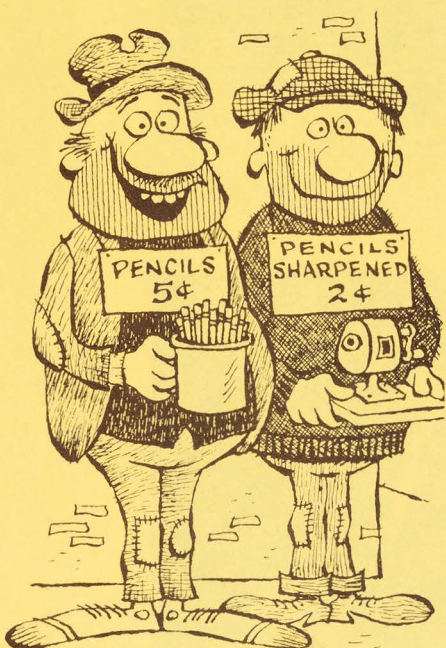

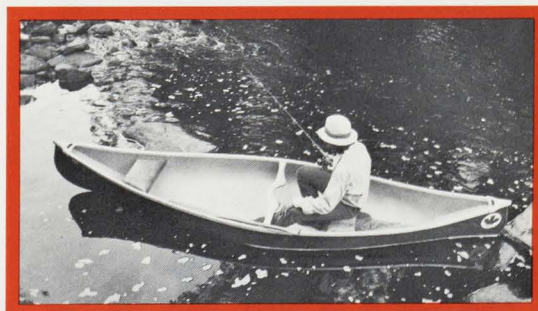
Our Written Guarantee:

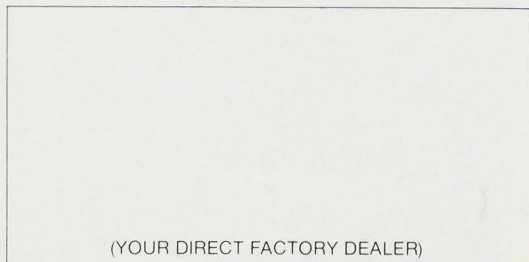
