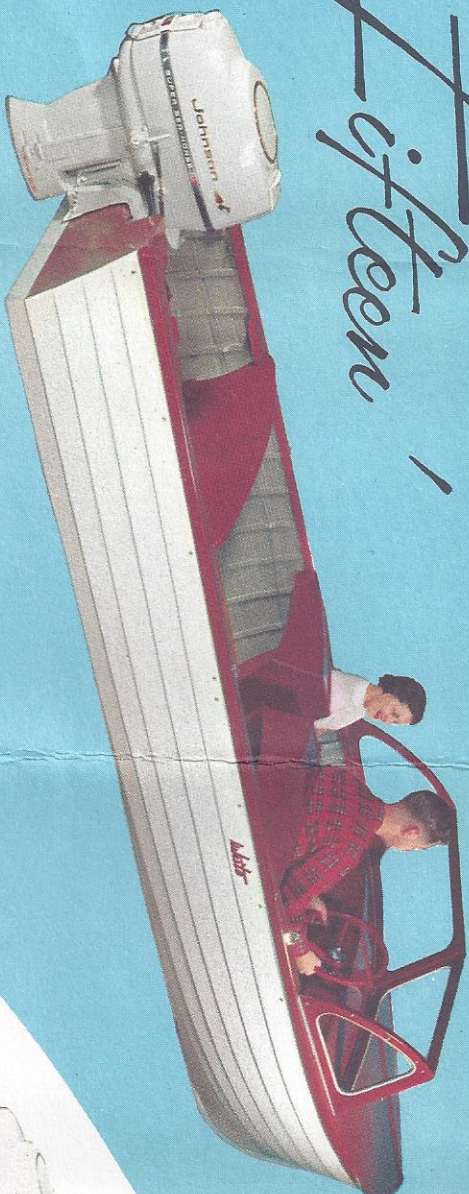

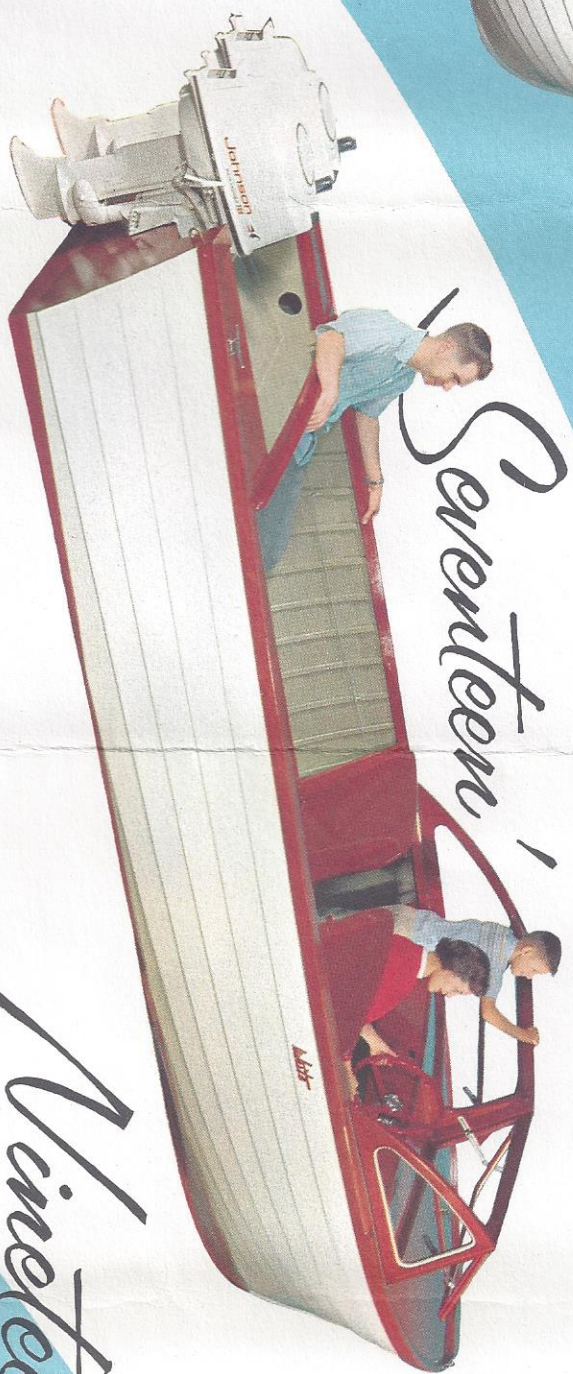

CONSTRUCTION

"White" monocoque construction differs from the conventional clinker construction in that its strength and ability to withstand unusual pounding, results from the lapped edges of the planking being bedded in a waterproof resin glue, thus forming a $\frac{3}{4}$ " 10 ply, glued up, longitudinal stringer on the edge of each plank.

All of the shock and stress which is absorbed by a "White" hull is not transmitted to its planking fastenings (which is the case in other clinker boats) but is absorbed by a tough glue line which is stronger than the wood itself, thus the working of seams and the shearing action on the fastenings is eliminated.

Only "White" offers this rugged monocoque construction. Most conventional clinkers are seamed with a mastic compound up to the water line only. "White" uses resin glue on *every lap*, plus the special copper clinching fastenings designed especially for "White".

This is no untried and unproven gimmick for a quick sale. "White" has been using resin bedded laps for ten years, and for 70 years has been producing canoes and boats of unmatched construction and performance, your assurance of custom quality. All fastenings are copper, bronze, or brass.

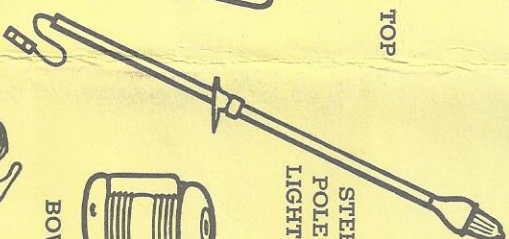

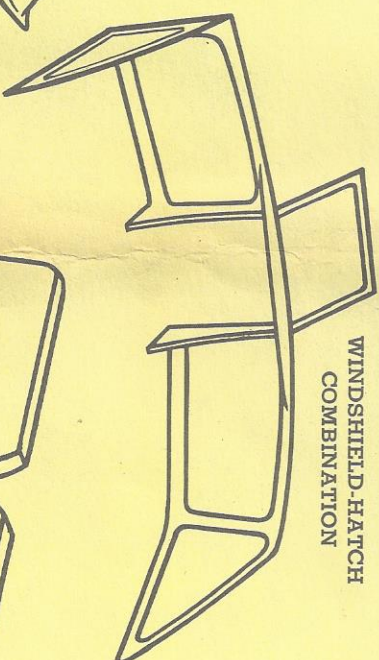

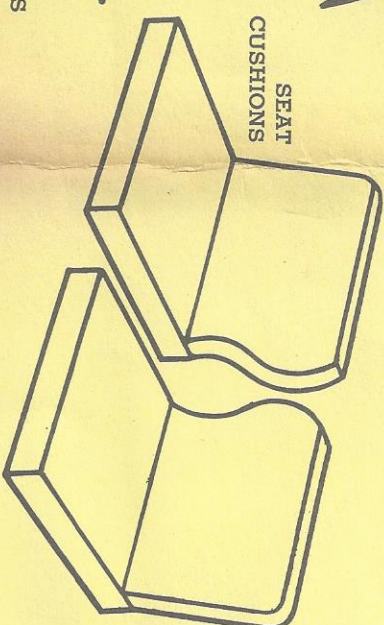
